

1 The Falcon Motor Club will organise a Duel Permit Clubsport / Production Car Autotest on 5th September 2004 at 165 Biggleswade Road, Upper Caldecote Beds.

2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motor Sport Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), the Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.

3 M.S.A. permit numbers 25706 (Clubsport) & 25705 (Production Car) have been issued.

4 The event is open to fully elected members of Falcon Motor Club,.

5 All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.

6 The programme of the meeting will be :- Scrutineering starts at 10.00am (any competitor not signed on by 10.45am may be excluded). The first car starts at 11.00am.

7 The Clubsport event will consist of four classes as follows:-

A) Engine over driven wheels up to 3744 mm long (12'3 ½")

B) Engine over driven wheels over 3744 mm long (12'3 ½")

C) Front engine rear wheel drive saloon cars any length

D) Sports cars, Kit cars and Specials.

D1) Autotest specials - Mini Scamp, Mini Champ, Mini Moke or similar cars may run in a separate class at the organisers discretion but will not qualify for the FTD award or championship points.

Overall length to include bumpers weather fitted or not

The Production Car event will consist of one class as follows:-

P) Saloon cars as defined in GR F 9.2.2. They must conform to F 12.4., be registered, taxed, insured and have a valid MOT certificate.

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8 All cars must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations, except the following which have been modified:-

E13.9.1 Knobbly tyres are not permitted.

E13.17.1 Silencers must be fitted and effective.

E13.8.1 Need not carry a spare wheel.

F11.8.1 Need not be registered or taxed. (Except for class P).

9 Awards will be presented as follows and will be perpetual.

FTD.

First in Class

Second in Class subject to 4 starters

Third in Class subject to 6 starters

Best Novice subject to 3 starters

Awards will be presented at the end of the event following publication of the results.

10 The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes on Sunday 5th September 2004

The entry fee is:- £6.00 if received by Wed 1st September 2004

£10.00 if received after Wed 1st September 2004

NOTE: A refund will be given if entry is withdrawn up to the day before event. (Before 9pm)

12 The maximum entry for the meeting is 25. The minimum is 8. The minimum for any class is 3. Should any of the above figures not be reached, by 1st September 2004 the Organisers reserve the right to cancel the Meeting or amalgamate classes as appropriate.

14 Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event finishes.

15 Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Regulations O 5.2.1 to O 5.2.8

16 a) Details of tests will be issued at signing on.

b) Each driver will have two runs, BEST time to count.

c) Timing will be by hand held watches

d) The starting signal will be verbal

e) Order of attempting tests will be consecutive.

17 Practising will not be allowed.

18 All other general regulations of the MSA apply as written except that as the event takes place on private land, and Pylons may be less than 1 Meter high.

19 Marking and penalties will be as printed in the MSA General Regulations

20 Toilet facilities will be available on site.

21 The Club sport event is open to competitors of sixteen years of age and above.

The Production Car event is open to competitors aged 14, 15, 16 years of age and those who do not hold a full RTA licence (B 8.3.5). The passenger must hold a full RTA licence and be experienced in Autotesting (F9.2.1). Attention is drawn to B 9.3.8. A parent or gardein must countersign the entry form of a competitor who is under 18 years of age.
